the story we know next to nothing of the man saul of tarsus sauls home was tarsus he was a jew and proudly a pharisee more importantly he was a zealot he studied under the great rabbi gamaliel we know nothing of his father not even his name except he was a roman citizen since sauls living came from tent making we can speculate that his father was a tent maker i have endeavored to recreate sauls early life and experiences on the basis of what we do know from the scriptures and from first century jewish culture to this are added logical suppositions this is a fictionalized history of saul up to the beginning of his ministries to the gentiles when he became the apostle paul the book introduces sauls family and presents a theory of why scripture is silent about them its narrative explores his early developing of zeal for the law it suggests early romance and why saul never married it explores his early training under the great rabbi gamaliel it shows sauls growing hatred of christians and

his zeal at persecuting them it examines sauls conversion and the changed and disruptions that entails it speculates his being in the school of christ during three years in nabatean desert it follows saul in his first evangelistic ventures it looks into his tentative approach to the disciples of jesus it speculates on initial meetings and development of relationships with barnabus and silas it explores some of the chastisements saul received as a result of preaching the gospel

fans of reese witherspoon s book club picks eager for their next moving historical novel look no further readers of the alice project and the lost girls of paris will be enthralled by v s alexander s the traitor drawing on the true story of the white rose the resistance movement of young germans against the nazi regime the traitor tells of one woman who offers her life in the ultimate battle against tyranny during one of history s darkest hours in the summer of 1942 as war rages across europe a series of anonymous leaflets appears around the university of munich speaking out against escalating nazi atrocities the leaflets are hidden in public places or mailed to addresses selected at random from the phone book natalya petrovich a student knows who is behind the leaflets a secret group called the white rose led by siblings hans and sophie scholl and their friends as a volunteer nurse on the russian front natalya witnessed the horrors of war first hand she willingly enters the white rose s circle where every hushed conversation every small act of dissent could mean imprisonment or death at the hands of an infuriated gestapo natalya risks everything alongside her friends hoping the power of words will encourage others to resist but even among those she trusts most there is no guarantee of safety and when danger strikes she must take an extraordinary gamble in her own personal struggle to survive praise for v s alexander s the irishman s daughter accompanied by an expertly rendered plot bold and empathetic characters and prose that jumps off the page this tale will particularly satisfy fans of historicals and those looking for stories about the redeeming grace of faith and hard work publishers weekly starred review

in september 1776 two men from connecticut each embarked on a dangerous mission one of the men a soldier disguised as a schoolmaster made his way to british controlled manhattan and began furtively making notes and sketches to bring back to the beleaguered continental army general george washington the other man traveled to new york to accept a captain's commission in a loyalist regiment before returning home to recruit others to join british forces neither man completed his mission both met their deaths at the end of a hangman's rope one executed as a spy for the american cause and the other as a traitor to it neither nathan hale nor moses dunbar deliberately set out to be a revolutionary or a loyalist yet both suffered the same fate they died when there was every indication that britain would win the american revolution had that been the outcome dunbar convicted of treason and since forgotten might well be celebrated as a martyr and hale caught spying on the british would likely be remembered as a traitor rather than a revolutionary hero in the martyr and the traitor virginia dejohn anderson offers an intertwined narrative of men from very similar backgrounds and reveals how their relationships within their families and communities became politicized as the imperial crisis with britain erupted she explores how these men forged their loyalties in perilous times and believed the causes for which they died to be honorable through their experiences the martyr and the traitor illuminates the impact of the revolution on ordinary lives and how the stories of patriots and loyalists were remembered and forgotten after independence
