wealth incompatible with true christianity in the good of affluence john r schneider reopens the debate over the proper christian attitude toward money arguing ultimately that scripture does indeed provide support for the responsible possession of wealth this is a provocative book of christian theology written to help people seeking god in a culture that has grown from modern capitalism by comparing classic christian teaching on wealth with the realities of our modern economic world schneider challenges the common presumption that material affluence is inherently bad careful interpretation of scripture narratives creation exodus exile and more also shows that abundance is the condition that god envisions for all human beings and that faithful persons of wealth are part of this plan schneider believes that the wealth as blessing themes of the old testament are not to be spiritualized and do not run contrary to new testament teachings but provide exactly the frame of reference for the incarnate identity life and teaching of jesus who came to make real the messianic feast both in this age and in the age to come through insightful engagement with the biblical text schneider overturns some of the most cherished and unquestioned assumptions of influential christian writers particularly ronald sider on modern capitalist affluence yet schneider s message is also finely balanced with the need for responsible christian living he offers rich christians biblical affirmation but also challenges them to a life shaped by an uncommon sense of stewardship and compassion incisive thought provoking and biblically grounded the good of affluence is a superb resource for anyone students professors

this is the fifth volume of dr justin glenn s comprehensive history that traces the presidential line of the washingtons volume one began with the immigrant john washington who settled in westmoreland co va in 1657 married anne pope and became the great grandfather of president george washington it continued the record of their descendants for a total of seven generations volume two highlighted notable family members in the next eight generations of john and anne washington s descendants including such luminaries as general george s patton the author shelby foote and the actor lee marvin volume three traced the ancestry of the early virginia members of this presidential branch back in time to the aristocracy and nobility of england and continental europe volume four resumed the family history where volume one ended and it contained generation eight of the immigrant john washington s descendants volume five now presents generation nine including more than 10 000 descendants future volumes will trace generations ten through fifteen making a total of over 63 000 descendants although structured in a genealogical format for the sake of clarity this is no bare bones genealogy but a true family history with over 1 200 detailed biographical narratives these in turn strive to convey the greatness of the family that produced not only the father of his country but many others great and humble who struggled to build that country advance praise i am convinced that your work will be of wide interest to historians and academics as well as members of the washington family itself although the surname washington is perhaps the best known in american history and much has been written about the washington family for well over a century it is surprising that no comprehensive family history has been published justin m glenn s the washingtons a family history finally fills this void for the branch to which general and president george washington belonged identifying some 63 000 descendants this is truly a family history not a mere tabulation of names and dates providing biographical accounts of many of the descendants of john washington who settled in westmoreland county virginia in 1657 each individual section is followed by extensive listings of published and manuscript sources supporting the information presented and errors of identification in previous publications are commented upon as

appropriate john frederick dorman editor of the virginia genealogist 1957 2006 and author of adventurers of purse and person decades of reviewing civil war books have left me surprised and delighted when someone applies exhaustive diligence to a topic not readily accessible dr glenn surely meets that standard with the meticulous research that unveils the washington family in gratifying detail many of them confederates of interest and importance robert k krick author of the smoothbore volley that doomed the confederacy and stonewall jackson at cedar mountain

pilgrimage beyond the officially sacred understanding the geographies of religion and spirituality in sacred travel examines the many ways in which pilgrimage engages with sacredness delving beyond the officially recognized and often religiously conceived pilgrimage sites as scholarship examining the lived experiences of pilgrims and tourists has demonstrated pilgrimage need not be religious in nature nor be officially sanctioned rather they can be hyper meaningful voyages set apart from the everyday profane life in a word they are sacred separating the social category of religion from the sacred this volume brings together a multidisciplinary group of scholars employing perspectives from anthropology geography sociology religious studies theology and interdisciplinary tourism studies to theorize sacredness its variability and the ways in which it is officially recognized or condemned by power brokers rich in case studies from sacred centers throughout the world the contributions pay close attention to the ways in which pilgrims central authorities site managers locals and other stakeholders on the ground appropriate negotiate shape contest or circumvent the powerful forces of the sacred delving beyond the officially sacred this collective examination of pilgrimages both well established and new religious and secular authorized and not presents a compelling look at the interplay of secular powers and the transcendent forces of the sacred at these hyper meaningful sites providing a blueprint for how work in the anthropology and geography of religion and the fields of pilgrimage and religious tourism may move forward pilgrimage beyond the officially sacred will be of great interest to an interdisciplinary field of scholars the chapters were originally published as a special issue in tourism geographies

the preservation of history and slavery in the united states has its legacy connected to the civil war and the 13th amendment this is the same legacy that created great american literature and gave rise to mark twain samuel clemens as an acclaimed writer of huckleberry finn and his main characters tom sawyer and companion jim the legacy of celia adams continues to reveal this deeply preserved and long tradition of contemporary discussions the book reveals the conditions in which celia adams a remarkable freedom dweller of her era endured it identifies relatives from her lineage and shares stories as told to them from the voice of celia adams celia adams was born before the civil war march 12 1856 until her death on march 21 1943 during world war ii she had the vantage of living forty four years in the 1800s and another forty three years in the 1900s the legacy of celia adams provides the verisimilitude to assess the conditions of her life under the institution of slavery the lynching of her husband and through slaverys generational impact on her off springs the majority of the eleven children of celia adams lived through the 1960s with the last child living in the 1980s this book shares many of these rich stories of her legacy as told by her children and grandchildren the authors grandfather was one of her eleven children the writer interviewed many of these relatives in addition he heard numerous porch stories from his grandfather who moved from gough georgia to fort lauderdale florida to escape the unyielding conditions and the lingering effects of slavery this book allows the audience to read and glean many of the family secrets and preserved stories from slavery to freedom this book is historic because it reveals the generations and names of the off springs of celia adams and the story of an almost forgotten legacy of one of this nations freedom fighters of the 1800s it is timely because it allows the public an opportunity to reflect on the conditions that gave rise to the 13th 14th and 15th amendments to the u s constitution the 13th amendment provides the nation with cause to reflect on the 150 year jubilee the abolition of slavery from 1865 2015 is the sesquicentennial of the 13th amendment jubilee as celia adams said to her children it was some jubilee
